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# Compound Morphology: Examples

- **Deverbal nouns have only syntactic paraphrases:**
  - билколечение ('herbcuring', curing by herbs)
  - \* **билколекувам** (\*‘herbcure.1PERS.SG’, to cure with herbs) and
  - лекувам с билки ('cure.1PERS.SG with herbs', to cure with herbs)
- **Deverbal nouns have also verb compound paraphrases:**
  - ръкомахане ('handwaving', gesticulating),
  - ръкомахам ('handwave.1PERS.SG', gesticulate) and
  - махам с ръка ('wave with hand', gesticulate).
