- 1. Welcome to participants Checking the quorum: 21 countries out of 30 are represented.
- 2. Adoption of agenda vote: 21 in favor, 0 against, 0 abstaining

- 4. Update from the Grant Holder

We have successfully submitted a report for the 2nd year of the Action. We have spent **96%** of the budget allocated for the year 2. During this year we have carried 9 STSMs and spent 64% of the budget planned for STSM's. In total we reimbursed 178 Action participants, including 53 participants at the Frankfurt meeting, 58 at the Malta meeting, 43 trainees and 5 trainers at the Prague Training School, and 19 intended participants reimbursed for the non- refundabale costs of the cancelled Haifa meeting.

We encountered some <u>delays with the payments</u> in the second half of the budget year due to organisational issues at COST and delay with the funds allocation on their side.

 - a. Scientific strategy
 - Advances in organizing a <u>shared task</u> dedicated to <u>automatic detection of</u> <u>verbal MWEs</u> (organizers: Veronika Vincze and Antoine Doucet) – 17 expressions of interest for <u>15 languages</u> so far; see the WG3 meeting
 - b. Action Budget Planning

Work and Budget Plan for year 3 has been approved (via an e-COST vote). Lower buget due to COST savings: <u>170,000 EUR</u> (194,000 EUR in year 2).

- c. Long-term planning (including anticipated locations and dates of future activities)
 - PARSEME/ENeL workshop in Skopje, FYR Macedonia, 5-6 April 2016 proposed hotel reimbursement rate: <u>65 EUR</u> per night (two of the recommended hotels offer rooms for 45 and 53 EUR) vote: **21 in favor**, **0 against**, **0 abstaining**
 - 6th general meeting, Struga, FYR Macedonia, 7-8 April 2016 proposed hotel reimbursement rate: 45 EUR per night (price for a single room in the conference hotel); the proposal has been increased to <u>50 EUR</u> per night -

vote: 21 in favor, 0 against, 0 abstaining

- 7th general meeting in autumn 2016 1 proposal:
 - Dubrovnik, 26-28 September 2016 organizers: Croatian Language Technologies Society and the University of Zagreb, Croatia; presentation by Marko Tadić; 2 days for the general meeting + 1 day excursion

vote: 21 in favor, 0 against, 0 abstaining

Vote by secret ballot:

in the 1st round: 7 in favor of the UK, 6 in favor of France, 3 in favor of Serbia, 5 in favor of Poland

(after the 1st round of voting the MC Member from Greece, Stella Markantonatou, left the meeting)

- 2nd round: 10 in favor of the UK and 10 in favor of France
- → the next round of voting will finally take place remotely, only 2 proposals, from the UK and France will be concerned by the vote vote: 20 in favor, 0 against, 0 abstaining

- A <u>dissemination paper</u> on the action, authored by the SC members submitted to the LTC 2015 conference in Poznań, Poland, 27-29 November 2015
