

The organizer's proposal of the Second PARSEME Training School

Dates	4-8 July 2016
Location and the available rooms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Venue: University of Warmia and Mazury in Olsztyn, Poland, the Faculty of Humanities and the Faculty of Mathematics and Computer Science located in an academic campus. The campus is about 15 mins by bus from the city centre and about 12 mins by bus from the old town. Olsztyn is a touristic city surrounded by several lakes and forests. There are 5 large conference rooms for 136-366 persons and 30 rooms for 30 persons each in the building of the Faculty of Humanities and 10 computer labs for about 20 persons each in the building of the Faculty of Mathematics and Computer Science. The faculties are located in new modern buildings about 5 mins on foot away from each other.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Accommodation <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – rooms in the dormitories in the academic campus at the Kortowo Lake about 3 mins from the Faculty of Humanities (more about campus: https://www.youtube.com/watch?list=UUipsgcNtifVK_Va95Sm8WXw&t=1&v=WpWBMKthboI) – rooms in the Hotel HP Park (nearby the campus; about 7 mins on foot from the Faculty of Humanities and the Faculty of Mathematics and Computer Science) and in other hotels in Olsztyn.
Access by public transport	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • to Olsztyn: about 2,5-5 hours by train or buses directly from the airports in Warsaw (225 km), Modlin (170 km), Gdańsk (185 km); e.g. the cost of the bus from the Warsaw airport directly to Olsztyn (a bus stop near the university campus) - 28 zł (7 euro) • in Olsztyn: about 40 public buses and trams
Estimation of hotel room prices	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • dormitory: 70-80 zł (17-20 euro) • the Park Hotel (**): 200-275 zł (48-65 euro) • other hotels in Olsztyn: 100-480 zł (24-115 euro)
