Manfred proposed Martin Hilpert who does construction grammar and is a good lecturer.

- WG2: CCG, Grammatical Framework, construction grammar (Martin Hilpert?),
- WG3: people from Wolverhampton,

• (proposal from later discussions): Walenty + Polfie (by Adam et al.): the whole processing chain from the lexical encoding of MWEs in a valence dictionary to the LFG rules and text parsing; lab on MWE encoding in English with a toy LFG grammar
