



- Systematic study of (the syntactic flexibility of) idioms in 14 varieties of Dutch
- Online searchable database
- Focus on functional projections
- Internal syntax (DP structure)
 - Idiomatically Combining Expressions vs. Idiomatic Phrases
 - In ICEs, determiners follow regular syntax
 - In IdPs, definite determiners are semantically vacuous
- External syntax (idioms and phase size)
 - IdPs cannot straddle phase boundaries (DPs are not phases)
 - Some idioms depend on tense, aspect, modality, voice
 - Size of clause-internal phase varies cross-linguistically
