- ❖ Common template for classification of multiword names in different languages.
- ❖ Semantic classes define:
 - ❖ a) semantic pattern for a group of proper names;
 - ❖ b) semantic pattern of their trigger.
- ❖ Syntactic patterns define:
 - ❖ c) syntactic pattern for a group of proper names belonging to one semantic class;
 - ❖ d) syntactic pattern of their trigger.
- ❖ Semantic classes capture the general semantics of multiword names.

NAMES *LEGISLATIVE*

Semantic pattern of the name

A given name modified with or substituted by family name(s). The trigger is obligatory.

Semantic pattern of the trigger

Modifiers (optional): describing a person.
Complements (optional): in-something; of-a-country; for-something

Examples

BG министър-председателят на България
Стефан Стамболов

EN the prime minister of Bulgaria
Stefan Stambolov

FR le premier ministre français Manuel Valls

GR ο πρωθυπουργός της Ελλάδας Αλέξης Τσίπρας

SR premijer Srbije Zoran Đinđić
